

41 WORKERS REMAIN TRAPPED

Tunnel mishap: Expert call for scrutiny was ignored

THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT ignored a recommendation that it conduct a formal environmental risk study on a highway tunnel project that collapsed and trapped 41 workers.

While large projects in India are required by law to undergo an Environmental Impacts Assessment, the Silkyara Tunnel in Uttarakhand was exempt as it is divided into segments smaller than 100 km each. So the Supreme Court in 2019 asked an expert panel to suggest risk mitigation options.

"We wrote to the government asking them to conduct a rapid EIA" but the study wasn't submitted, Ravi Chopra, the panel's chairman, said by phone on Tuesday.

Typically, planned large infrastructure in India undergoes an Environmental Impacts Assessment, or EIA, which examines its projected impacts on local biodiversity and geology. It is meant to help project designers weigh economic benefits against the environmental

damages involved in any new construction.

Spokespeople for the ministry of environment, forest and climate change and the ministry for road transport and highways did not reply to a request for comment. The tunnel is part of the Chardham project,

a nearly 900 kilometre connectivity plan announced by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2016.

The \$1.4 billion project aims to boost pilgrim tourism across four religious sites in the region, bolster military logistics and improve connectivity for

residents of the state. The committee identified numerous problems. Its members warned that the nature of the soil, consisting in part of crushed rocks and limestone would exacerbate the existing risk of landslides and flash floods in the state.

NHAI to undertake safety audits of all under-construction tunnels

The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) will carry out a safety audit of more than two dozen tunnels it is building after one such tunnel in the Himalayas collapsed this month, trapping 41 construction workers, the government said on Wednesday.

Rescuers have been battling to pull out the 41 men stuck in a 4.5-km (3-mile) tunnel in the mountainous Uttarakhand state since it caved in early on November 12.

Authorities have not said what caused the collapse, but the region is prone to landslides, earthquakes and floods. The construction spree has been questioned by some environmental experts who fear damage to the fragile Himalayan ecosystem and on grounds of safety.

"To ensure safety and adherence to the highest quality standards during construction, NHAI will undertake safety audit of all 29 under construction tunnels across the country," the government said in a statement. The NHAI is a federal body which builds and manages a network of national highways.

NHAI officials along with others from the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation will inspect ongoing tunnel projects and submit a report in seven days, it added.

Breakthrough hopes in rescue ops up

A BREAKTHROUGH IN THE Uttarkashi tunnel rescue appeared on the horizon Wednesday as rescuers made swift progress drilling through 55 metres of debris behind which 41 men have been trapped for over 10 days.

It was on Friday that a heavy-duty machine drilling into the rubble ran into trouble around the 22-metre mark, and the process had to be halted. After repairs were made, drilling resumed on Tuesday, and by Wednesday evening, a pipe had been inserted into the debris up to 42 metres. It is through this pipe that the men are expected to be pulled out.

While rescuers had started working on five operations simultaneously to rescue the men, the one on the Silkyara end is the most promising.

Mahmood Ahmad, the managing director of National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL), said that after 900 mm pipes got stuck and stopped moving further, rescuers decided to push 800 mm pipes through the wider ones using the "telescopic method". "After pushing the 800 mm pipes, we started the drilling around 12.45 pm and we are happy to announce that we have drilled through around 39 metres and placed the pipes too. It is a matter of joy for us. However, till we are not inside by around 45-50 metres, we cannot say anything with full confidence," said Ahmad in the afternoon.

Later in the day, an official press release stated that "about 67% augur drilling" had been completed, and "horizontal pipe inserted up to 42 metres".

Ahmad said during the day that at the current speed, if there is no new hurdle, the trapped workers could be out by late Wednesday night or Thursday morning. Ambulances also started arriving at the site, with one vehicle for each worker expected to be stationed at the entrance of the tunnel before the men come out. Uttarakhand Government Secretary Neeraj Khairwal confirmed that after a visual communication was established on Tuesday, officials have also been successful in establishing an audio communication channel after sending a microphone and speaker to the other end of the six-inch supply pipe. "On this side, we are using headphones to talk to them. Using this channel, our doctors talked to them and asked about their well-being. Some of them complained of constipation

and medicines were provided," he said.

The official informed that basic items like undergarments, towels, toothbrush and other essentials were also provided. A full meal,

including daal filled in plastic bottles, along with mixed vegetable, roti and rice wrapped in aluminium foil, were also sent to the men.

Five agencies - ONGC, SJVNL, RVNL, NHIDCL, and

THDCL - have been assigned specific responsibilities in the rescue operation, working collaboratively "with occasional task adjustments for operational efficiency," officials said.
