

RGU holds AICTE-VAANI National Conference

Manjit Hazarika (Cotton University), Dr. Bhaskar Kumar Kakati (IIT Jodhpur), agri-entrepreneur Samir Bordoloi, and Retd. IFS officer Abhijit Rabha. Scholars, professionals, and practitioners engaged in insightful sessions and paper presentations over the two days. On Day 1, discussions centered on themes such as Indian Knowledge Systems for Energy, Nature, and Sustainability; Traditional Ecological Knowledge and Modern Science; Indigenous Pathways to Climate Resilience; and Sustainable Architecture and Economy. Alongside, scholars presented research papers that explored the intersections of traditional wisdom and modern challenges. The second day of the conference opened with a plenary session titled “Resilient Futures: A Reflection.” Sessions on 16th September focused on Indian Knowledge Systems and Science: Prospects for a Sustainable Future; Energy, Sustainability, and Cultural Applications of IKS; Green Entrepreneurship and Indigenous Innovations in Energy Transition; and the Integration of Traditional Knowledge with Modern Science for Policy and Development. The valedictory session underscored the urgent need to mainstream Indian Knowledge Systems into education, research, and sustainable development policies. The two-day deliberations concluded with a collective call to revitalize indigenous wisdom as a guiding force in tackling the global challenges of climate change, energy transition, and cultural sustainability.

Authorities Warn Against Fake Stamp on Bhupen Hazarika Govt Releases Official Rs100 Commemorative Coin

**Assam Rising, Guwahati, Sept 16:** Authorities have issued a stern warning after a fake commemorative stamp of Bharat Ratna Dr Bhupen Hazarika began circulating on social media, calling it misleading and unrelated to official releases. Digboi MLA Suren Phukan condemned the act, saying, “Such actions dishonor one of Assam’s greatest sons. Everyone must refrain from sharing fake content and help preserve his legacy.” The BJP Assam Pradesh unit, CMO Assam, and leaders including Dilip Saikia also urged the public to verify sources before forwarding unverified material. Officials from the Ministry of Finance and India Post clarified



that only the officially gazetted Rs100 commemorative coin and stamp, released on government portals, are legitimate. The Centre unveiled the special Rs100 silver coin on September 13 in Guwahati to mark Hazarika’s birth centenary. Released by Prime Minister

Narendra Modi in the presence of Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma, the coin bears Hazarika’s portrait alongside the Ashoka Pillar, symbolizing his enduring legacy as the “Bard of the Brahmaputra.” The event also featured the launch of a commemorative postage stamp, honoring Hazarika’s unparalleled contributions to music, poetry, and cultural unity.

Obituary Bhaskar Baruah

**Assam Rising, Nagaon, September 16:** Bhaskar Baruah, a young entrepreneur and resident of Amulapatty in Nagaon, passed away last night while undergoing treatment at Gauhati Medical College Hospital. He was 50 years old. Baruah, popularly known as Piku, had been suffering from a complex illness for some time. He was a well-known figure in Nagaon, actively involved in various social activities. Baruah had previously been associated with the NSUI, the student wing of the Congress party, and had served as a member of the Nagaon district committee. Baruah leaves behind his wife and many relatives. His passing has left a void in the lives of those who knew him.
