
# Modi a man of 'profound inner power': Brazilian Vedanta teacher

## Shah calls for swift deportation and extradition of drug traffickers operating from abroad eliminating the drug menace, which

In a strong message aimed at tightening the noose around international drug syndicates and fugitive criminals, Union Home Minister Amit Shah today emphasised the urgent need for expediting both deportation and extradition processes

Addressing the 2nd National Conference of Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) heads of states and union Territories here, Shah underlined that those fuelling drug trafficking and operating from foreign soil must be swiftly brought under the ambit of Indian law.

Praising the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) for its efforts in this field, Shah called for coordinated and collective action stating that curbing narcotics not only addresses drug abuse but also weakens the funding channels for terrorism and

organized crime.
Shah further stressed that while criminals deserve no leniency, India must adopt a more pragmatic and liberal approach to the procedures involved in their deportation. Adding that the Home Ministry is preparing a SOP for the same.

New Delhi (UNI)

Terming India's defence sector as an amalgamation of the "offensive and defensive capabilities", Defence Minister Rajnath today called upon the Commanders to be proactive in their approach and strive to build the Sudarshan Chakra as envisioned by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Stating that a committee has been formed to examine the project and prepare a "realistic action plan", the Minister suggested devising a medium-term plan for the next five years and a long-term plan for the next ten years to bring the vision to fruition.

The Defence Minister addressed the Combined Commanders' Conference 2025 in Kolkata, a Defence Ministry statement said.

Rajnath emphasised the need for



constant assessment of the changes taking place across the globe and its impact on the security system of the country, in view of the turbulent global order, regional instability and emerging security landscape. Asserting that the nature of war-

fare is continuously evolving, and

the recent global conflicts have underlined the relevance of a "technology-friendly" military, the Minister said, "wars of today are so sudden and unpredictable that it is extremely difficult to foretell its duration. It can be two months, a year, or even five years.

We need to be prepared. We need to ensure that our surge capacity remains sufficient".

Highlighting that the country's defence sector is centered around modernisation, operational readiness, technological superiority and credible deterrence, he called for focusing on the mantra of "JAI (Jointness, Aatmanirbharta and Innovation)" given by Prime Minister in the inaugural session of the conference yesterday.

New Delhi (UNI) The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has

summoned cricketers Robin Uthappa and Yuvraj Singh and Bollywood actor Sonu Sood for questioning in the 1xBet Money Laundering case. Sources told UNI that the agency

has scheduled their appearances at its Delhi headquarters on different days. Robin Uthappa is required to appear on September 22, followed by Yuvraj Singh on September 23, and Sonu Sood on September 24. According to ED sources, these

celebrities had participated in promotional campaigns for 1xBet, which significantly helped the illegal platform build a substantial user base in India despite its prohibition. The agency also issued a statement expressing concern about a new threat emerging from the recent

ban on regulated money gaming

apps. It warned of a potential rise in

illegal betting platforms targeting

users in India and emphasized the

need for focused strategies to





counter this challenge.

Officials provided staggering figures to illustrate the scale of the problem, noting that in the first quarter of this year alone, illegal betting websites received more than one billion hits.
