During the meeting, the Prime Minister conveyed his warm congratulations to President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi for Egypt's crucial role in the Gaza Peace Agreement and expressed hope that it

would lead to lasting peace in the region. "Foreign Minister Abdelatty briefed the Prime Minister on the first India-Egypt Strategic Dialogue alongside External Affairs Minister (EAM) S Jaishankar on Thursday evening. During the meeting, EAM Jaishankar highlighted that India and Egypt share commitment to the progress of the Global South. "India and Egypt share a commitment to the progress of the Global South and the strengthening of independence and freedom of choice of nations in world affairs. This solidarity will surely guide our discussions today," EAM Jaishankar said in his opening remarks at the strategic dialogue.

"India and Egypt share a commitment to the progress of the Global South and the strengthening of independence and freedom of choice of nations in world affairs. This solidarity will surely guide our discussions today," EAM Jaishankar said in his opening remarks at the strategic dialogue. EAM Jaishankar also mentioned that the first India-Egypt Strategic Dialogue is a milestone in bilateral ties which have seen intensified cooperation in various domains since the elevation of the relationship to the level of a Strategic Partnership in 2023. "Our political contacts and coordination have been strong and sustained, includ-

ing in the multilateral side. Our defence and security exchanges have grown. Trade and investment continue to be promising, and we will discuss how to take them forward. We can also explore possibilities in digital public infrastructure, fintech, pharma, space, startups, and green technologies. As befitting two old civilizations, culture and people-to-people exchanges also occupy an important place in our ties," the EAM said in his remarks. He stated that, keeping with the longstanding friendship between both nations, it was natural that Egypt assisted India in the evacuation of Indian nationals from the region in June 2025. "I would also like to place on record our deep appreciation for the solidarity that your Government and you personally displayed in the aftermath of the Pahalgam terrorist attack. Prime Minister Modi and President Sisi spoke to each other at that time. We noted the warm welcome you accorded to the multi-party parliamentary delegation that visited Egypt after that," he said.

Major Crackdown onLiquor Mafia in Lohardaga



LOHARDAGA: In a major breakthrough against the liquor mafia, Lohardaga police have seized a massive consignment of illegal foreign liquor from a container truck and arrested two persons. The operation was conducted by Kudu police under the leadership of Superintendent of Police (SP) Sadique Anwar Rizvi and SDPO Shraddha Kerketta. During a press briefing on Friday, SP Rizvi informed that the police received a tip-

off about a closed container truck (registration number BR 01 GL-7659) carrying a large quantity of illicit English liquor, moving through the Kudu area via Chandwa. Acting swiftly, a special team was formed including Kudu Police Station In-Charge Manoj Kumar and SI Hemant Kumar, who set up a vehicle checking drive near Setu Garage, close to the Kudu bus stand. At around 6:00 PM on Thursday evening, the police intercepted a suspicious container and upon inspection, discovered a huge consignment of Seagram's Imperial Blue Whisky concealed inside wooden boxes. The seizure included: 172 cartons (2064 bottles) of 750 ml bottles, 95 cartons (2304 bottles) of 375 ml bottles, and 145 cartons (6960 bottles) of 180 ml bottles, making a total of 11,328 bottles or approximately 3,664.8 liters of illegal liquor. The driver, Anil, son of Baran Singh, and the helper, Brijesh Kumar, son of Satya Prakash-both residents of Faridabad, Haryana were taken into custody. Need structured policy to strengthen India's domestic industrial base: Defence Secretary

NEW DELHI : Defence Secretary Rajesh Kumar Singh on Friday underlined the need for a structured policy framework to strengthen India's domestic industrial base through a balanced synergy between public and private sectors. His remarks came at the inaugural address at the 'Strategic Insight Conference on Indigenous Development of Critical Technologies for Air Power' organised by the Centre for Aerospace Power and Strategic Studies (CAPSS) in New Delhi on October 17, 2025.



The Defence Secretary emphasised that the diversification of the industrial base will end monopolies, enhance ease of doing business, and promote innovation across the ecosystem. He reiterated the government's steadfast commitment to Aatmanirbharta in defence, stressing the importance of developing advanced aero technologies, field evaluation trials, and long-range air-to-air missile systems to strengthen India's air power capabilities. Notably, the Vice Chief of the Air Staff, Air Marshal Narmadeshwar Tiwari, highlighted the contribution of air power in determining strategic results, as seen during Operation Sindoor. He said that "apart from capabilities to design and develop indigenous aircraft, India should also prioritise achieving expertise in electronic warfare, advanced sensors, radars, and data links." Director General, AERO, DRDO K. Rajalakshmi Menon highlighted the disruptive potential of UAVs, multi-sensor fusion, and artificial intelligence in air operations. She also spoke of advancements in stealth

technology, aerostats, and airships equipped with enhanced sensors, as well as the integration of quantum, photonic, and blockchain technologies in defence systems. DG, CAPSS, Air Vice Marshal (Retd) Anil Golani drew attention to the significance of Aatmanirbharta amid the evolving security environment and the growing technological competition in the neighbourhood. As part of the event, the Defence Secretary released a book, 'Asian Defence Review 2025: Geo-political Shifts and Strategic

Partnership Multilateralism in the Indo-Pacific'. Multiple technical sessions covering indigenous jet engine co-development, fighter aircraft programmes, unmanned systems, and strengthening the aerospace production ecosystem were also held. The conference witnessed senior officials from the Ministry of Defence, the Indian Air Force, DRDO, and industry leaders coming together to discuss India's journey towards technological self-reliance in the aerospace and defence realms.

Centre's funding of projects in northeast jumped 74 pc to Rs 3,447 crore in FY 25

NEW DELHI : Union Minister for Communications and Development of North Eastern Region, Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, on Friday highlighted that the ministry's expenditure on projects in northeast had touched an all-time high of Rs 3,447.71 crore in FY 2024-25 -- marking a 74.4 per cent increase over the previous year and more than 200 per cent growth in three years.

This performance, he noted, reflects the emphasis of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (MDoNER) on fiscal discipline, digital monitoring, and timely delivery. Weekly review mechanisms and digital tracking through the 'Poorvottar Vikas Setu' portal have brought transparency and efficiency, resulting in 97 per cent project inspection coverage and 91 per cent operationalisation of completed projects. "The Northeast today represents the spirit of a new India - empowered, connected, and future-ready. Guided by the Prime Minister's vision, the region has transformed from a frontier into a front-runner, symbolizing confidence and competitiveness," the minister noted. In a major governance reform, the ministry has institutionalised Chief Minister-led sectoral high-level task forces across eight sectors such as tourism, investment, handicrafts, agriculture, infrastructure, sports, north east economic corridor and protein self-reliance. These task forces are fostering inter-state collaboration, enabling policy alignment, and ensuring that development efforts are regionally integrated rather

Farmers should get adequate fertilisers for Rabi crops: Shivraj Singh Chouhan

BHOPAL : Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, on Friday, visited his parliamentary constituency of Vidisha in Madhya Pradesh and reviewed the developments, issues related with farmers, especially fertilisers, during a meeting at the district headquarters. While reviewing compensation for the loss in soyabean crop in Vidisha, Union Minister Chouhan asked the district administration to conduct an authentic survey through crop-cutting experiment and send to the Agriculture Ministry through the Madhya Pradesh government so that farmers can get benefits of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana. "If district administration would send authentic survey reports on loss of soyabean crop, I will personally step forward.

Statehood is delayed to J&K for reasons best known to BJP: Omar Abdullah

SRINAGAR : J&K Chief Minister Omar Abdullah said on Friday that statehood was being delayed to J&K for reasons best known to the BJP. Speaking to reporters in South Kashmir's Kulgam district, Omar Abdullah said he is continuously trying for the restoration of statehood to J&K so that the elected government has more powers. He squarely blamed the BJP for what he called "delaying the grant of statehood to J&K for reasons best known to the BJP."

Speaking about his government's decision to restore the over hundred fifty-year-old tradition of shutting the top offices of the government between Srinagar and Jammu on a six-monthly basis called the Darbar Move', the Chief Minister said, "It was a promise made to the people and we have fulfilled it." The shifting of offices in the civil secretariat, those of the Chief Minister, his cabinet colleagues and all top officials to Jammu during the winter and Srinagar during the summer was stopped by the Lt Governor, Manoj Sinha, in 2021. As per the decision taken by the government headed by Omar Abdullah, the civil secretariat will close in Srinagar on October 31 and reopen in Jammu on November 3. Each government employee who shifts for the Darbar.
