

1984 Anti Sikh riots: Court convicts former Congress MP Sajjan Kumar in murder case

NEW DELHI : The Rouse Avenue court convicted former Congress MP Sajjan Kumar in a 1984 Anti Sikh riots case.

This case is linked with the killing of father son duo in Saraswati Vihar area on November 1, 1984. Sajjan Kumar is serving a life sentence in another anti Sikh riots case of Delhi Cantt.

Special judge Kaveri Baweja pronounced the judgement and convicted Sajjan Kumar.

Sajjan Kumar was produced physically before the court. On January 31, the court had reserved the order after hearing additional submissions by the Public Prosecutor Manish Rawat.

This case is related to the killings of one Jaswant Singh and his son Tarandeep Singh in Saraswati vihar area on November 1, 1984.

Advocate Anil Sharma had submitted that Sajjan Kumar's name was not there from very beginning, law of foreign land is not applicable in this case and there was a delay of 16 years in naming Sajjan Kumar by the witness.

It was also submitted that a case in which Sajjan Kumar was convicted by the Delhi High Court is pending appeal



before the Supreme court.

Advocate Anil Sharma had also referred to the case cited by the senior advocate HS Phoolka. He submitted that the law of the land will prevail even in the extraordinary situation and not the international law.

Additional Public Prosecutor Manish Rawat in rebuttal had submitted that the accused was not known to the victim. When she (a family members killed in the riots) became aware that who is Sajjan Kumar she named him in her statement.

Earlier, Senior advocate H S Phoolka had appeared for riots victims and argued that the police investigations were

manipulated in the Sikh riots cases. Police investigation was tardy and to save the accused.

It was argued that during riots situation was extraordinary. Therefore, these cases have to be dealt with in this context.

During the arguments senior advocate H S Phoolka had referred to judgement of Delhi High Court and submitted that it is not an isolated case, it is a part of bigger massacre, it is a part of genocide. It was further argued that as per official figures 2700 Sikhs were killed in Delhi in 1984. It was an ordinary situation.

Senior Advocate Phoolka had referred to the Delhi High Court judgement in 1984 Delhi cantt case wherein the court called the riots crime against humanity. It was also said that objective of genocide is always targeting of minorities. There is a delay. Supreme court took it seriously that there is delay and a SIT was constituted, he argued. Senior advocate had also referred to the judgement delivered by foreign courts in the cases of genocide and crime against humanity. He also referred to Geneva Convention.

It was also submitted that a charge sheet was prepared against Sajjan Kumar in 1992 but was not filed in the court. It shows that the police was trying to save Sajjan Kumar. On November 1, 2023, the court had recorded the statement of Sajjan Kumar. He had denied all the charges levelled against him. Initially an FIR was registered in Punjabi Bagh police station. Later on, this case was investigated by the Special Investigation Team constituted on the recommendation of justice G P Mathur committee and filed a charge sheet.

The committee had recommended the reopening of 114 cases. This case was one of them. On December 16, 2021, the court had framed charges against the accused Sajjan Kumar for commission of the offences punishable under Section 147/148/149 IPC as well as the offences punishable Under section 302/308/323/395/397/427/436/440 read with Section 149 IPC.

To protect the environment we have announced Mahakumbh as plastic-free, we have planted trees, we have also implemented schemes on solid waste," Uttar Pradesh Principal Secretary said. Meanwhile, the Magh Purnima 'snan' concluded successfully today at the Mahakumbh mela in Prayagraj. Urban Development Department Secretary Anuj Jha said that the conclusion of the 'snan' was a huge milestone in itself. "The snan of Magh Purnima has been concluded successfully."

Delhi: Man stabs in-laws after they intervene in fight with wife, arrested

NEW DELHI : A man allegedly stabbed his mother-in-law, brother-in-law and two sisters-in-law after the family members intervened in the altercation between the accused and his wife, said the police on Wednesday.

Police said that the incident occurred in Vasant Kunj South area of southwest Delhi.

Following the incident, the brother-in-law is reported to be seriously injured, while the other three victims sustained minor injuries. The police were informed of the case on Monday, and the injured were quickly taken to hospital.

The accused was arrested on Tuesday, and an investigation into the matter is underway.

Authorities revealed that the incident followed a domestic dispute between the accused and his wife, during which the in-laws had intervened.

In another incidence of violence on Tuesday, two minors were detained by the Delhi Police for allegedly killing a minor boy, who used to bully them, officials said.

The incident happened on February 9. The police received information at around 9: 45 pm, that an injured person was lying on Street Number 7 in Gautampuri was received at Seelampur police station.

A team of police reached the spot immediately, where they found the victim boy lying in a pool of blood with stab marks and various other injuries. The crime and forensic teams were called by the police to examine the crime scene, and the boy's body was sent to the GTB hospital. The police also deployed sources, after which they managed to identify and detain two minors aged 15-16. A knife which was used as a weapon to kill the boy was recovered from their possession. During the interrogation, both minors revealed that the deceased and they belonged to the same locality. The deceased boy was known to them and frequently bullied both the accused. According to the accused, the deceased boy asked the detained CCLs to pay money to him, which they weren't able to pay. Subsequently, they assaulted him. The police are yet to find the third counterpart of the two detained minors, and efforts to nab him are underway.

Assam: Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary witnesses 15% increase in revenue collection this season

Boeing thrives when US-India relationship is strong, says Boeing India President



BENGALURU : Boeing India and South Asia President Saili Gupte on Wednesday said the relationship between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and US President Donald Trump, both at a government-to-government level and at a personal level holds much importance for the global aerospace manufacturer.

"It means a lot because Boeing of course thrives when the US-India relationship is strong," Gupte told ANI on the sidelines of the Aero India 2025 show here today, ahead of a meeting of the two leaders at the White House.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to arrive in the US on February 13 at the invitation of President Donald Trump.

On possible Boeing assembly units in India, Gupte said, "In the past, we have had MoUs where we have committed to doing that

here in India for fighters. Now, we haven't been chosen yet on fighters, but we hope that will happen in the future. And we expect that we'll have to make a similar commitment."

Boeing, the leading foreign aerospace manufacturer in India, has said that it has to build the supply chain so that it can localize production here in India. "We generate over Rs 10,000 crore per year in exports, which is probably 30 to 40 per cent larger than our next largest competitor, that go from India largely to the US today," Gupte said. "At the same time, India and Indian airlines are also buying billions of dollars of US airplanes in civil and defence sectors every year. That is a wonderful example of a great two-way street when it comes to trade," Gupte said.

Meanwhile, in his departure statement, PM Modi said

he looked forward to meeting his friend, President Trump. "This will be our first meeting following his historic electoral victory and inauguration in January. I have a very warm recollection of working together in his first term in building a Comprehensive Global Strategic Partnership between India and the US," PM Modi said. This visit will be an opportunity to build upon the successes of "our collaboration in his first term and develop an agenda to further elevate and deepen our partnership, including in the areas of technology, trade, defence, energy, and supply chain resilience", the Prime Minister said in his departure statement. "We will work together for the mutual benefit of the people of our two countries and shape a better future for the world," PM Modi said.
