

INS Vagsheer commissioned into Indian Navy in presence of PM Modi

MUMBAI : INS Vagsheer, the sixth P75 Kalvari-class submarines, was officially commissioned into the Indian Navy in presence of the Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday.

The event was also attended by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, Indian Navy Chief Admiral Dinesh Tripathi and several other senior dignitaries. Naval Group's Chairman & CEO, Pierre Eric Pommelot, was also present alongside Naval Group's team from France and India, to mark this significant milestone, according to a Naval Group release.

INS Vagsheer is built by the Indian shipyard Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) based on the Naval Group's Scorpene design.

Launched on 20 April 2022, INS Vagsheer has completed successful sea trials and now joins its sister vessels INS Kalvari, INS Khanderi, INS Karanj, INS Vela and INS Vagir, which were commissioned respectively in December 2017, September 2019, March 2021, November 2021 and January 2023.

As per the release, Pierre Eric Pommelot, Chairman and CEO said: "We are hon-



oured to be part of the success of the P75 program, a cornerstone of the Indo-French strategic partnership and a key achievement in India's 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' policy. Naval Group remains fully committed to supporting the Indian Navy through future projects alongside Indian industrial partners."

The commissioning of INS Vagsheer highlights the success of India's indigenous submarines construction programme. This submarine has been fully built by MDL, with technology transfer from Naval Group, in line with the Indian Government's "Make

in India" policy. The series of six submarines of the P75 program is fitted with a number of equipment built locally by qualified and highly trained industrial including Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). MDL and Naval Group have developed a rich industrial ecosystem of more than 100 Indian companies, along with an Indian subsidiary employing more than hundreds of Indian engineers to support the Indian Navy, the release stated.

This strategic partnership contributes to industrial and technological sovereignty

while opening new markets opportunities for local industries, showcasing their experience gained through the program. The Scorpene is a 2000 tons conventional-propulsion submarine designed and developed by Naval Group for all types of mission, such as surface vessel warfare, anti-submarine warfare, long-range strikes, special operations or intelligence gathering, according to the release.

Extremely stealthy and fast, it has a level of operating automation that allows a limited number of crew, which reduces its operating costs

significantly. Its combat edge is highlighted by the fact that it has 6 weapon launching tubes and 18 weapons (torpedoes, missiles), the release stated. With 14 submarines operating or under construction chosen around the world and more than 5 submarines which have been chosen and awaiting start of construction very soon, the Scorpene is an essential reference of conventional attack submarines (SSK) for Navies across the globe. The product is easily adapted to specific requirements of any naval customers. The progressive improvement by Naval Group dedicated and experienced designers ensures the seamless integration of advances and modern technology.

Naval Group, a long-term partner of India Naval Group is present in India through its 100% subsidiary Naval Group India. Farmers protest: SC seeks Dalalwadi's health reports to get AIIMS medical board's opinion

NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court, appearing for the



Court on Wednesday sought from the Punjab government complete comparative medical reports of farmer leader Jagjit Singh Dalalwadi, who is on an indefinite fast, to obtain an opinion from the medical board of AIIMS.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant and N Kottiswar Singh asked the Punjab government to submit Dalalwadi's test reports during the course of the day to the top court's Registrar. The Registrar then to communicate the reports to the AIIMS director for an opinion on Dalalwadi's test reports from the medical board, said the bench. Senior advocate Kapil

Punjab government, told the bench that there is now a medical facility just 10 meters near the protest site and that Dalalwadi's parameters are "improving".

To this, Justice Kant asked how a person, who had been on fast for nearly 50 days had his health param-

eters improving. Sibal further clarified that Dalalwadi's parameter is not improving rather it is stable.

The apex court now posted the case for hearing on January 22.

The top court was hearing a contempt petition filed against the Punjab Chief Secretary and Director General of Police of Punjab for not complying with December 20 order of providing medical aid and hospitalisation to Dalalwadi, who is on a fast-unto-death since November 26. Dalalwadi, the convener of the Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non-Political) has been on a fast-unto-death at the Khanouri border to press the Centre to accept.

Court grants custody parole to Delhi riots accused Tahir Hussain to file nomination



NEW DELHI : Delhi's Karkardooma Court on Wednesday granted custody parole to Tahir Hussain for January 16 to file a nomination for Delhi assembly election.

Hussain is contesting Delhi State assembly elections on the ticket of the AIMIM party.

Additional Sessions Judge (ASJ) Sameer Bajpai granted custody parole to Hussain. The court has also directed to take Tahir Hussain to the office of SDM Karawal Nagar for nomination on January 16, and again on January 17 if in case his nomination is not completed on January 16.

He was granted custody parole by the High court in

Ankit Sharma murder case on Tuesday. His interim bail plea was dismissed by the High court.

Meanwhile, Karkardooma Court has also granted custody parole to Shifa Ur Rahman to file election nomination on the same dates. He is also contesting Delhi State assembly election on the ticket of AIMIM.

His plea seeking interim bail has been kept pending for hearing on January 21 by the court. His counsel Bilal Anwar Khan said.

On Tuesday sureties bonds furnished for former AAP MCD Councillor in eight criminal cases in which he has already been granted bail.

In view of this, Additional Sessions Judge Sameer Bajpai Karkardooma court on Tuesday adjourned hearing on his other interim bail application till Wednesday.

Tahir Hussain has 11 case against him related to Delhi Riots case including one registered under Money laundering case.

Advocate Rajiv Mohan appeared before the Karkardooma Court and submitted that order on the plea of Tahir Hussain is pending before the Delhi High court.

Tahir Hussain has been given a ticket to contest Delhi Assembly Election 2025 by AIMIM.

BJP is biggest danger to jhuggi clusters in Delhi: Manish Sisodia

NEW DELHI : Ahead of the Delhi assembly elections, Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) candidate from Jangpura, Manish Sisodia on Wednesday launched a scathing attack against the Bharatiya Janata Party alleging it to be behind the deteriorating law and order condition in the national capital.

Further, he alleged that the BJP is the biggest threat to slum dwellers in Delhi.

"I am getting a lot of love and support from the people of Jangpura. It is a big day for me today. Poor law and order, raps, chain snatching, gang wars- BJP is behind all this. BJP has not been able to handle law and order here, so why should we give education and hospitals to them?... Today, the BJP is the biggest danger to jhuggi clusters in Delhi. If they come to power all jhuggis will be razed. We



are the only ones... who lie down in front of bulldozers to prevent such actions," said Sisodia while speaking to ANI during his roadshow in Jangpura.

Meanwhile, after the Centre granted the ED the nod to prosecute him and Manish Sisodia in an alleged liquor scam case, AAP Chief Arvind Kejriwal said that they (BJP) are contesting the

Delhi Assembly Polls this way. On being asked by the reporters outside the party office when he was enrooled to file his nomination, Kejriwal said, "Woh uss tarah see chunav lad rahe hain, hum is tarah see chunav lad rahe hain." The Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has authorized the Enforcement Directorate (ED) to initiate prosecution

against former Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and former Deputy CM Manish Sisodia under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) for their alleged involvement in money laundering linked to the liquor scam case. The sanction order against these AAP leaders was received earlier this month in a fresh development to the case pertaining to the alleged irregularities in the now-scrapped Delhi liquor policy for 2021-22.

Sisodia is pitted against BJP leader Tarvinder Singh Farwah and Congress' Marwan Suri in the Jangpura seat.

Uttarakhand fully prepared for 38th National Games: Chief Minister Dhama

DEHRADUN : Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama has said that Uttarakhand is fully prepared for the 38th National Games.

It is a matter of joy that every section is ready to join the National Games in some form or the other. This is a huge celebration of sports, which will prove to be important from the point of view of sports development in Uttarakhand, the CM said as per a press release.

A total of 1200 special sports volunteers will also be deployed in the National Games. These volunteers will be made available to Uttarakhand at the level of the National Sports Federation of India. Uttarakhand is also going to select about 2300 general volunteers from its own level. Special sports volunteers will be different from them. However, along with the general volunteers, they will also be provided training in behaviour and etiquette, the release mentioned.



The 38th edition of the National Games is scheduled to start on January 28. Two types of volunteers will contribute to making all kinds of arrangements. Out of this, the process of recruitment of general volunteers is currently going on. More than 30 thousand people have registered to become volunteers. All of them have been given online training. Online examination has also been taken. Volunteers will be recruited on the basis of their results, said the release.

According to Prashant Arya, Additional Chief Executive Officer of the National Sports Secretariat, apart from general volun-

teers, special sports volunteers will also be deployed. Uttarakhand will get these volunteers through the National Federation of Sports of India, who will be deployed at various places. National Federation Sports of India provides these special sports volunteers. These volunteers have experience in national and international-level competitions. While general volunteers are used in other general arrangements related to parking, bringing and taking guests, special volunteers are given responsibility in arrangements directly related to sports, the release added.

According to Prateek Joshi, who is the work related to volunteers, special sports volunteers will be given an honorarium of one thousand rupees.

Maha Kumbh: Cleaning campaign started after Amrit Snan
