

NEET 2024: Delhi HC issues notices to NTA, seeks response on pleas of aspirants



NEW DELHI : The Delhi High Court on Wednesday issued notice to National Testing Agency (NTA) in a batch of petitions filed by NEET aspirants. Aspirants have raised the issue of leakage of question paper, awarding compensatory marks and anomaly in question of NEET 2024. A large number of petitions are pending before different High Courts.

Justice Neena Bansal Krishna has issued notice to NTA and listed the matter on July 5. Advocate Gauhar Mirza and Suriti Chaudhary submitted before the court that there are absolute irregularities.

During the matter,

Solicitor General (SG) Tushar Mehta appeared and submitted that there are multiple petitions in seven High Courts.

"We are seeking transfer of those petitions to Supreme Court. The court may accommodate the time so we may file transfer petition in the Supreme Court," the SG said.

He also submitted some matters that were listed on July 8 before the Supreme Court. "We (NTA) are in the process of filing of transfer petition," he said.

The counsels for petitioners submitted, "Let them file a reply. That can be treated as reply before the Supreme Court."

The bench noted that there are three broad issues namely Paper leakage, grace/compensatory marks awarded, and anomaly in the questions.

There are petitions that have been filed before the Delhi High Court raising these issues.

Shreyanshi Thakur, Mohd. Florez, Keya Azad, Adarsh Raj Gupta, Anadvaya V have moved the Delhi High Court seeking different prayers. They have sought a direction to declare the arbitrary grace marks illegal and award equal marks to all questions to all those who didn't attempt the impugned wrong questions.

PM Modi to visit Varanasi on June 18, release Samman Nidhi instalment to benefit farmers

NEW DELHI : After the formation of the Modi government for the third consecutive time at the Centre, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit his parliamentary constituency of Varanasi for the first time on June 18. The PM will address a Kisan Sammelan in Varanasi during his one-day visit. The Prime Minister will stay in his parliamentary constituency Varanasi for 4.5 hours. He will reach Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport Babatpur at around 4:30 pm. From there he will go straight to the venue. The PM will be given a grand welcome at various places throughout the way. Prime Minister Modi will honour farmers from Varanasi and release the 17th instalment of the Samman Nidhi, benefitting about 267,665 farmers in Kashi. This visit is dedicated to the farmers. Following the Kisan Sammelan, he will visit the Baba Kashi Vishwanath Temple and participate in the world-famous Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat. BJP Kashi Zone President Dilip Patel said, "It is a matter of pride for all of us that Prime Minister Narendra Modi took oath as MP from Varanasi for the third time and as Prime Minister of the country for the third time. After being elected as the Prime Minister of the country and MP from Varanasi for the third time, he is coming to Varanasi on 18 June". Patel stated, "Modi's guarantee is well-known; he is the only trustworthy leader . who follows up on his promises. After being sworn in as Prime Minister, his initial efforts focused on the farmers. In Varanasi, he will distribute the 17th instalment of the Samman Nidhi, amounting to over Rs 20,000 crores, to the farmers. He will also address the Kisan Sammelan in Mehndiganj Gram Sabha of Sevapuri Assembly of Varanasi Lok Sabha and interact with the farmers." The BJP in Varanasi has started preparations for Prime Minister's programme, party workers are busy preparing for the grand welcome of PM Modi. All party workers have been assigned responsibilities for the Kisan Sammelan.

Swati Maliwal assault case: Bibhav Kumar moves Delhi HC for regular bail

NEW DELHI : Bibhav Kumar, former aide of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, moved the Delhi High Court on Wednesday seeking regular bail in the Swati Maliwal alleged assault case. The matter is likely to be listed on Friday.

Recently, Delhi's Tis Hazari Court dismissed the regular bail plea of Bibhav Kumar. The court dismissed the bail application in view of threats received by the victim, Swati Maliwal and apprehension of influencing the witnesses by the accused.

While dismissing the bail application, the court observed, "In view of the fact that investigation is at an initial stage and there is a fear in the mind of the victim regarding her security as well as the security of her family members.... There is also apprehension that the accused Bibhav Kumar would influence the witnesses, if at liberty."

"So I do not find any merit in the bail application of accused Bibhav Kumar. Hence, the present regular bail application of accused



Bibhav Kumar is hereby dismissed," Special judge Ekta Gauba Mann ordered on June 7.

The victim has alleged that her family and extended family members are getting continuous threats. She also stated that she is scared as there is a risk to her life as well as the lives of her family members if the accused is granted. She strongly opposed the bail application.

It is the second bail plea

which has been dismissed by the court. His first regular bail plea was dismissed on May 27. While seeking bail, defence counsel argued that accused is a PA to the CM since 2010, at a time when Kejriwal was not appointed as the CM. He is only a PA to the CM and gives appointment as per the direction of the CM. He also relied upon the Complaint filed by the assistant section officer of camp office at the CM's resi-

dence to his department regarding the time of arrival of the victim and accused on May 13.

The victim opposed the bail application and stated that the accused is a very influential person and after she made a complaint against him, all the leaders of her political party and cabinet ministers are busy in victimising or engaged in character assassination and she has been ostracised by her

entire political party as she has made a complaint against the accused.

She also stated that accused Bibhav Kumar is an influential person and under the protection of leaders of his political party.

She also stated that a fake video was made by the accused after the incident has already occurred. She also stated that the alleged doctored and edited video that was leaked by the accused is of no use since the video does not pertain to the time of the incident, but after the incident had already occurred and she had made a call to the police.

Additional Public Prosecutor (APP) Atul Srivastava opposed the application and submitted that the investigation is going on and the accused is an influential person. There is a case pending against him in Noida. He should not be granted bail.

It was also submitted that as per the Investigating Officer there is no proper register maintained for appointments to meet the CM at his residence.

Court issues notice to IO, ACP Crime branch on investigation in extortion case against Lawrence Bishnoi

NEW DELHI : Delhi's Saket Court called for a report from the Crime Branch of Delhi Police on the ongoing investigation in connection with a case of alleged extortion lodged against Lawrence Bishnoi and others.

Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Deepika Devesh also issued notice to the Investigation Officer (IO) and Assistant Commissioner of Police in the matter and directed him to file a proper reply.

"Let notice be issued to the concerned IO as well as the concerned ACP, Crime Branch, to file a proper report regarding further ongoing investigation in the present matter by the next date of hearing," CMM Deepika Devesh ordered on May 31. The matter has been listed for a hearing on July 18. The court called for the report after perusing the supplementary charge sheet, which shows that further investigation of some accused persons who are evading the process of law, namely Anuj and Anmol Bishnoi, is to be filed. In July 2023, the Court took cognizance of the charge sheet filed against.

Union Minister Kirti Vardhan Singh to visit Kuwait to oversee assistance to Indians injured in fire tragedy

NEW DELHI : Minister of State for External Affairs Kirti Vardhan Singh is urgently travelling to Kuwait on the instructions of PM Modi to oversee assistance to Indians injured in the fire tragedy in a southern city of the country early on Wednesday.

The minister will also coordinate with local authorities for early repatriation of the mortal remains of those who have died.

"As directed by PM @narendramodi, MoS for External Affairs @KVSinghMPGonda is urgently travelling to Kuwait to oversee assistance to those

injured in the fire tragedy and to coordinate with local authorities for early repatriation of mortal remains of those who have died in this unfortunate incident," Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said in a post on X.

Kirti Vardhan Singh, who took charge of his office on Tuesday, told the media that PM Modi has called a meeting. He said immediate action will be taken.

"PM Modi has called us for a meeting and after the meeting we will visit Kuwait. An immediate action will be taken," he said.

A fire broke out in a build-

ing housing workers in the city of Mangaf in southern Kuwait early on Wednesday.

India's ambassador to Kuwait, Adarsh Swaika, visited the Al-Adan hospital where over 30 Indian workers are being treated.

Amb @AdarshSwaika visited the Al-Adan hospital where over 30 Indian workers injured in today's fire incident have been admitted. He met a number of patients and assured them of full assistance from the Embassy," the Indian Embassy in Kuwait shared on X. The ambassador also visited Farwaniya Hospital, where six workers, who are

expected to be mostly Indians, who got injured in the fire incident were admitted.

Among those six, the hospital authorities confirmed that four of them have been released, one has shifted to Jahra Hospital and one in the ward is stable now.

Earlier, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar expressed his deep shock over the news of the fire incident. "Deeply shocked by the news of the fire incident in Kuwait city. There are reportedly over 40 deaths and over 50 have been hospitalized. Our

"Will serve people": Jyotiraditya Scindia after taking charge as Minister of Development of North Eastern Region in Modi 3.0



NEW DELHI : Bharatiya Janata Party leader and Union Minister Jyotiraditya M Scindia said revolutionary changes will be continued in the north-east region, after officially taking charge as the Minister of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER) in the newly formed BJP-led NDA government on Wednesday adding that he will serve the people.

The newly appointed Minister of DoNER received a warm welcome with bouquets from his colleagues and top officials of the ministry.

Along with Jyotiraditya M Scindia, Sukanta Majumdar also took charge as Union Minister of State (MoS) in the Ministry of DoNER.

After taking charge, Scindia said, "It is an unknown fact but I have had a dear connection with northeast states as my aunt (father's elder sister) was married in Tripura. Since then, I have had this connection with

the northeastern states." Scindia further stated, "Today, with the blessings of the PM, I have got an opportunity to serve the northeast states. With this opportunity, I and Sukanta Ji will serve the people of North-east."

Responding to the questions about the developmental progress of the region, Scindia asserted, "There has been a revolutionary change in the region since Prime Minister Modi Ji has assumed office and this journey will continue."

Earlier, on June 11, Jyotiraditya Scindia on Tuesday assumed charge as Union Minister of Communications also. After taking charge, he told media persons that he was honoured to be given the ministry by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

A descendant of the former royal family of Gwalior, Scindia severed his ties with the Congress party in 2020

after 18 years and joined the BJP along with his 22 loyalist MLAs in Madhya Pradesh.

The BJP had nominated him to the Rajya Sabha and entrusted him with the responsibility of the Civil Aviation Ministry.

Scindia began his journey in public service in 2002. He has also been a five-term Member of Parliament of India.

He has also been a five-term Member of Parliament of India. In the Lok Sabha (2002-04, 2004-09, 2009-14 and 2014-19), and the current term in the Rajya Sabha, representing the state of Madhya Pradesh.

In the 2024 Lok Sabha polls, Jyotiraditya Scindia won from Madhya Pradesh's Guna.
