Congress says decline in real wages of workers in past 10 years, seeks minimum wage of Rs 400



NEW DELHI: Congress on Thursday said that multiple data sources, including government's own official statistics, show that "workers can buy less today than they could 10 years ago" and the Union Budget offers a chance to provide "justice to labourers" by guaranting a nationwide minimum wage of Rs 400 per day of work.

In a statement, party general secretary Jairam Ramesh said that multiple data sources, including the government's own official statistics, "are unanimous in showing that workers can buy less today than they could 10 years ago".

"A combination of slow wage growth and backbreaking inflation has caused an unprecedented decline in real wages (wages adjusted

for price rise)," he said.
Referring to Labour
Bureau's Wage Rate Index, he said "real wages for labourers stagnated between 2014-2023, and in fact declined between 2019-2024". The former union minister referred to Ministry's Agricultural Statistics at a Glance and said under the UPA government led by Dr Manmohan Singh, real wages for agricultural labourers grew at 6.8 per cent each

"Under Mr Modi, real wages for agricultural labourers declined by -1.3 per cent each year," he said.

Jairam Ramesh said according to Periodic Labour Force Survey Series data, average real earnings over time have stagnated between 2017 and 2022 across all employment types - salaried workers, casual workers, and self-employed workers. Referring to Centre for

Labour Research and Action data, he said real wages of brick kiln workers have stagnated or declined between 2014 and 2022. The Congress leader said brick kilns involve intensive labour and are a low-paying work of last resort for India's poorest.

"To deliver justice to our shramiks, and to dispel this cycle of stagnant wages, the INC had guaranteed a nationwide minimum wage of Rs 400 per day of work in its Nyay Patra. The self-anointed non-biological PM has been delivered a stinging rebuke by voters in his efforts to reach 400 paar in the Lok Sabha. The Union Budget offers him the chance to achieve what the INC has called 'asli 400 paar',' Ramesh said. "A nationwide minimum wage of Rs 400 per day is an idea whose time has

NEW DELHI : Vice-President, Dhankhar on Thursday expressed concern over the disproportionate coverage given by media to incidents of limited impact, which overshadow substantive and long-term initiatives.

Lamenting over commercialization and control of media for motivated narratives, Dhankhar acknowledged journalism's crucial role in sustaining democracy. He called on the media to rise above partisan views and avoid aligning with political agendas or forces against national interests.

"It is time for soul searching. I appeal to the media in all humility and earnestness to be partners in growth. They can do this by highlighting good works and being critical of wrong situations and deficiencies," he said.

Drawing parallels with the solemnity of the Constituent Assembly, where democratic ideals were revered and disruptions unheard of, the Vice-President expressed concern over the growing trend of disruptions and sensationalism in parliamentary proceedings.

"The Constituent Assembly was a temple of democracy, where every session contributed to the foundation of our nationhood without any disruptions or disturbances," he

He noted that disruption and disturbance have regrettably become political tools rather than exceptions.

Highlighting concerns over Media's tendency to glorify disruption, the Vice President called upon the media to reassess their priorities in covering parliamentary proceedings. He expressed that when disruptions become headlines and disruptors are hailed as heroes, journalism fails in its duty to uphold democratic values.

The Vice President urged the media to uphold its responsibility in portraying an accurate image of India's to the world.

HYDERABAD : After the Uttar Pradesh Police ordered eateries, along the route of the Kanwar Yatra to display their owners' name, AIMIM Chief Asaduddin Owaisi on Thursday slammed Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and challenged him to issue a written order if he has the "courage.

Addressing a press conference, Owaisi said, "We condemn it because it is a violation of Article 17 of the Constitution, which talks about untouchability. So the Uttar Pradesh government is promoting untouchability. This kind of order that people should express their religion is a violation of Article 21 (Right to life) and also Article 19 (Right to livelihood). Secondly, ever since the Uttar Pradesh government has given the order, Muslim employees have been removed from all the Dhaba (shops) in Muzaffarnagar. There are many big and famous restaurants on that highway, why are you not anything about
